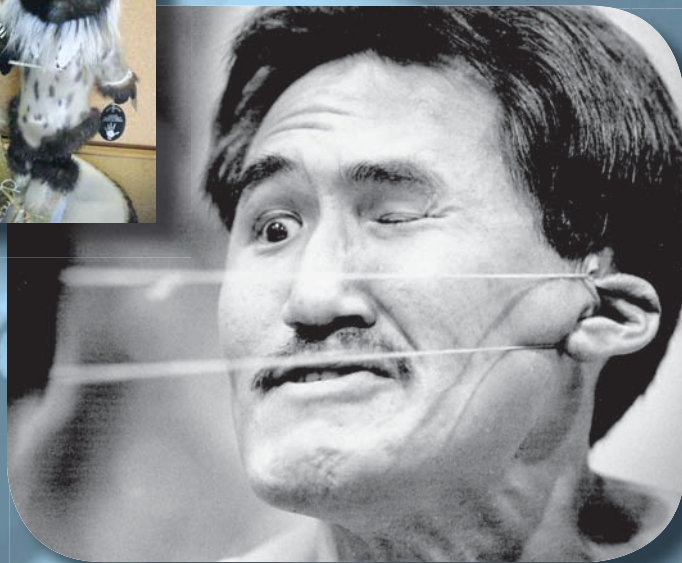




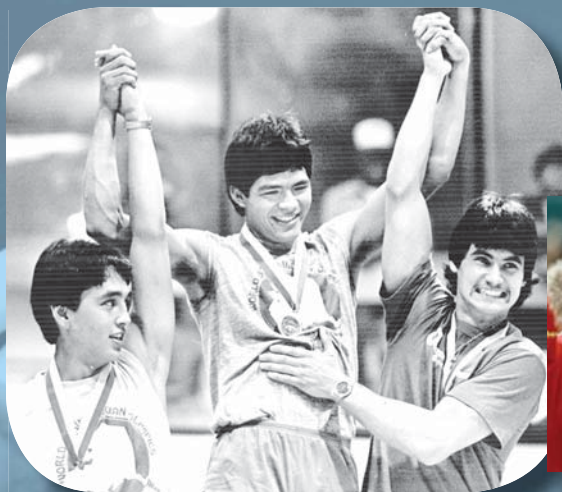

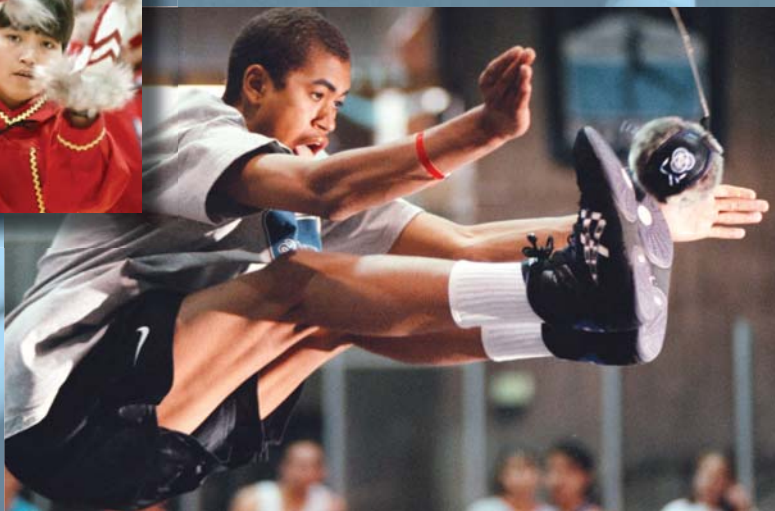

The roots of many of the games may be found in lessons passed down through generations and highlight agility, endurance and balance – all needed for survival in the far North.



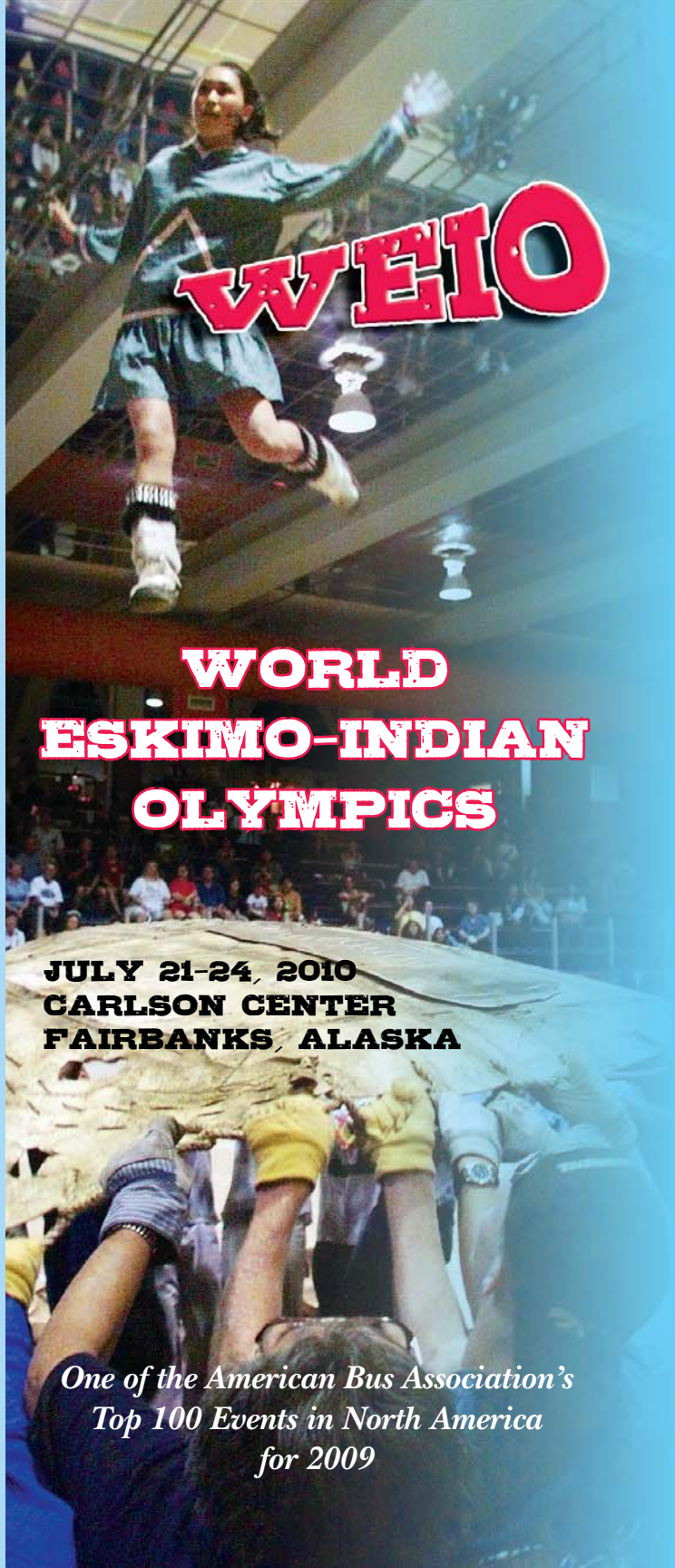
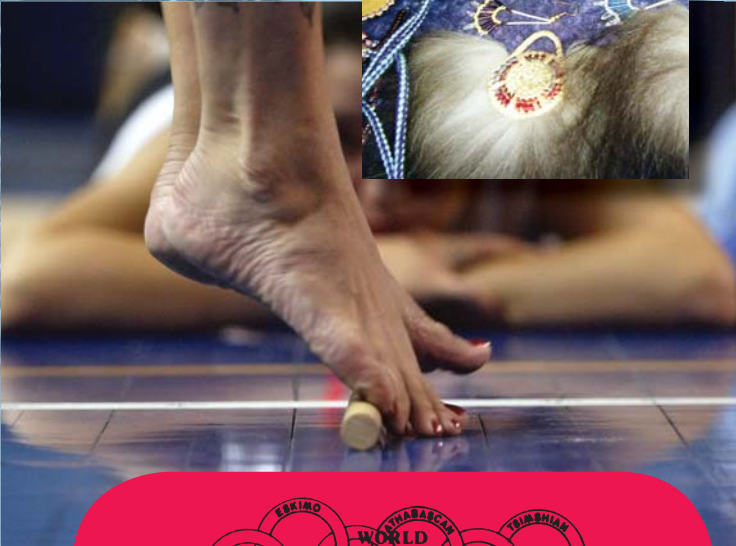
